Items for Consideration

Recess the Town Council Meeting, Convene as the Local Liquor Licensing Authority

MOTION: Mayor A Riddile made a motion to recess the town council meeting and to convene as the local liquor license authority. Councilor Hazelton seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Consider an Application from EAT Bistro & Drinks, LLC for Modification of Existing Liquor Licensed Premises

Clerk Harrison told the council that the owners of EAT Bistro & Drinks, Molly Mogavero and Jeff Ellis, had obtained the appropriate permits and were almost done with an expansion of their restaurant building located at 316 W Main Street. The special meeting was being held because the modification of their existing liquor license was something that had been

overlooked in the construction and expansion process. Clerk Harrison said that Ms. Mogavero and Mr. Ellis had submitted the modification of premises application on January 2, 2020. She said that all the appropriate fees were paid and the application was complete. The application included an updated lease from the landowners to include the addition as well as a map that showed the current and proposed liquor licensed premises. The council greeted Ms. Mogavero and asked about the grand opening. Ms. Mogavero said there would be a soft opening on Saturday, and the grand opening was planned for Wednesday, January 22, 2020. She said there would be specialty cocktails available but other details had not been decided. She said that they were very excited about the new restaurant addition.

MOTION: Councilor Leland made a motion to approve the Application from EAT Bistro & Drinks for Modification of an Existing Liquor Licensed Premises. Mayor A Riddile seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The council congratulated Ms. Mogavero on the expansion of her restaurant. Ms. Mogavero thanked the council for convening a special meeting for her liquor application.

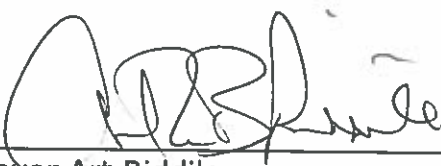

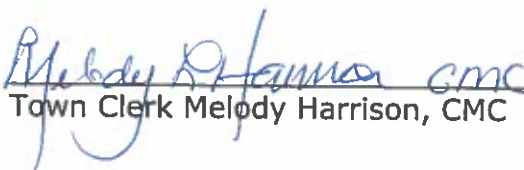
There were no council comments.
